**Please Bring:** Hat; insect repellent; binoculars and a hand lens, if you have them; long pants and appropriate footwear. No dogs, please. (Note: These events are free.)

**Location:** Meet in the parking lot of the **Golden LivingCenter-Lexington**. From Maple Street, turn onto Emerson Gardens Road and follow it to the end. Enter the facility's driveway (slowly, please) and continue around to the right, keeping the building on your left. Proceed to the far end of the parking lot.
