

**By-Laws of  
Friends of Arlington's Great Meadows**

1. **Mission.** Friends of Arlington's Great Meadows (FoAGM) is dedicated to the stewardship of Arlington's Great Meadows in East Lexington and its preservation as a natural landscape.
2. **Steering Committee.** The Steering Committee (SC) is the decision-making body of FoAGM.
3. **Steering Committee Members.**
  - a. The current and past members of the SC, and their terms, are listed in Schedule A.
  - b. The SC may appoint new members from time to time who have demonstrated a significant commitment to furthering the goals of the organization.
  - c. SC members shall serve until May 31 of the year following the year in which they are appointed, and they may be reappointed.
  - d. The number of members on the SC shall be not less than five nor more than eleven.
4. **Decision-making.**
  - a. The SC may act only:
    - i. at a meeting called with reasonable notice, including by email, to all of its members; or
    - ii. by written consent, including by email, of all of its members.
  - b. A majority of the SC members shall constitute a quorum at a meeting.
  - c. The SC shall make every effort to act by consensus.
  - d. If consensus cannot be reached, decisions may be made by a vote of two-thirds of the SC members present at a meeting, rounded up to the next whole number. For example, if five members are present, a decision may be made by a vote of four members (three and one-third rounded up to four).
5. **Officers.** The SC may designate members with special responsibilities, such as a presiding officer and a fiscal officer, for such periods of time as are deemed appropriate.
6. **Minutes.** The recorded and approved minutes of the SC shall constitute the official record of its actions.
7. **Public Participation.** FoAGM welcomes public participation in its meetings and activities.
8. **Amendments.** These by-laws may be amended by a vote of three-quarters of all currently serving SC members, rounded up to the next whole number. For example, if six members are serving, amendments may be made by a vote of five members (four and one-half rounded up to six). A history of amendments to date is contained in Schedule B.
